

Artist Challenge Sponsorship Levels

*One time donations include a dollar-for-ticket match for the event to participate in art activities, unlock supplies for the Artist Challenge and more!

\$10,000 Classroom residency sponsor!

Sponsors 4-6 weeks of in-classroom programming for an entire grade (200-500 students) at a Title-1 middle or elementary school in our community.

\$8,000 Mural sponsor!

Sponsors a collaborative community mural providing creative placemaking for up to 1,000 neighbors.

\$5,000 After-school residency sponsor!

Sponsors an 8-week after-school residency focused on art and mental health at a partner Title-1 high school.

\$3,000 Nonprofit sponsor!

Sponsors one year of programming (8-12 monthly events) with one of our partner nonprofit sites.

\$1,500 Mentor sponsor!

Sponsors an entire year of mentoring with an artist mentor or a student artist at a Title-1 high school.

We're thinking BIG and we're excited to invite you to think big with us!

O ver the next 3 years we're embarking on something super-huge, super-exciting, and also super-scary! We're growing to meet the incredible demand for our programming that has jumped by leaps and bounds in the era of the pandemic, the child and teen mental-health crisis, and social justice seekers.

In the last year, we've doubled our amazing staff to three full-time and two part-time people and we've already served over 3,000 kids so far in 2022. But we're already at capacity and have a waiting list stacking up, so we need more people so we can be in more places at once and serve more youth through our partnerships with local schools, nonprofits, and communities. We need to hire one more part-time staff member, increase our part-time hours, and bring our salaries up to market rate so we make sure our team can afford to stick around.

We're loving having space to spread out at our new home at Legacy Park and we're ready to expand our in-house programming with things like more family events, small group classes to help kids use creative play to practice things like emotional regulation and social skills, and to extend our hours in the summer with after-camp care to support working parents.

We're dedicated to paying fair wages to the teaching artists we work with on so that they can continue to be artists in our community. This means we can bring more diverse working artists into our programs and the kids we serve know there is a place for them in the arts.

Our model is really working and is scale-able. If we have the resources to scale, we could bring this high caliber of traumainformed, intentional, creative impact to so many more youth facing poverty and trauma in our community. So....

We're raising half a MILLION dollars in donations by 2025 so that we can reach 25,000 young people by Paint Love's 10th year!
